Why do we get these newsletters?
Great question! Our monthly newsletter is your BEST source of information regarding dates, details and reminders throughout our dance season. We cannot expect children to remember exactly what we tell them so we make sure to put our "news" in writing. It is the responsibility of the parent and/or guardian to make sure the newsletter gets home to you each month. Please take note:

1. AUGUST WILL BE THE ONLY (ACTUAL)HANDOUT NEWSLETTER THAT YOU RECEIVE. BEGINNING SEPTEMBER, ALL NEWSLETTERS WILL BE EMAILED, POSTED ON OUR WEBSITE TO DOWNLOAD AND POSTED THROUGHOUT THE STUDIO. WE WILL NOT BE PRINTING THEM OUT. FOOTNOTES IS GOING GREEN!!!

2. UPDATE YOUR EMAIL ON FILE IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE THESE UPDATES. THIS WILL KEEP YOURSELF INFORMED.

Reminders:

1. Footnotes will be CLOSED Monday, September 7th for Labor Day.

2. We understand that as parents you are very excited to watch your child during their dance class. We

keep the viewing windows closed EXCEPT for the first lesson of each month. This is the BEST way for their teachers to keep the class focused on the material being taught and not people looking through the window. Dancers have a difficult time concentrating when they know they are being watched. Thank you for your cooperation.

3. Red Registration Folders MUST be completed and signed before your child can participate in class. Please see the front desk to get your packet. Families must fill out and return the contract for EACH new season.

4. Dress Code is enforced on the first day of class. Families that are new to Footnotes, please see the front desk for your apparel and shoe requirements. Street shoes are not permitted.

5. Footnotes will be open Monday through Thursday from 11:00-6:00 and Fridays from 2:00-6:00. Please call the studio if you have any questions. Emails do not get checked daily; therefore, we prefer a phone call.

Lobby Etiquette: Footnotes provides an accommodating lobby for our dancers & parents; therefore, we expect those in our lobby to treat it as such:

1. No food or drinks (her than water) are permitted in the carpet area.
2. No strollers are permitted in the lobby due to fire hazard.
3. No cupcakes or edible treats can be handed out within the studio.

Please hand OUTSIDE of the studio.

4. Mark you name on your child's shoes, clothing, dance bag or whatever else you'd like returned if left behind.
5. Lost and found items will be held for 1 week then donated to Good Will.
6. Update email and payment info if/when needed.
7. No pets in the studio at anytime.
8. Please comfort crying children outside the studio.
9. Remember that the children are here to have fun and learn the art of dance!

Parent/Teacher Etiquette: Teachers move from one class to another as classes are often scheduled back-to-back. Teachers most often cannot stop and answer questions during their class times. Consequently, parents are instructed to leave a note for the instructor at the front desk. The front desk can normally answer your questions, so don't hesitate to ask them. Please read the handbook located in your Red Folder packet as it addresses this and other etiquette policies from Footnotes. You are giving your child the gift of dance. You are providing them with memories to last a lifetime!
